Call to Order

1. Prayer

Commissioner Frye led the Court in prayer to begin the meeting.

2. Pledge of Allegiance to the American Flag and the Texas Flag

The Court pledged their allegiance to the flags of the United States of America and the State of Texas.

3. Open Forum for Public Comments

No members of the public were in attendance.

4. Read and Approve Minutes of the Previous Meeting

Upon reading of the Minute of the last meeting, on a motion by Frye, seconded by Wilkins to approve the Minutes with a correction in regard to the Overpass; the minutes of the Regular Meeting on September 14, 2020 motion passed.

5. Consider Approval and Payment of the Accounts Payable - Sharon May
