Call to Order

1. Discussion and Potential Action Pursuant to Chapter 42 of the Texas Election Code and Other Authority Regarding Approval of a Revised 2021 Parmer County Election Precinct Plan, and All Related Matters

The County Clerk, Susie Spring presented the fact that the change in the Commissioner Precinct lines resulted in a necessary change to the Election Precinct # 303 lines by law.

At the same time as prescribed by the Texas Election Code, all precincts were reviewed. Due to the change in population, and the few numbers in some of the voting precincts, It was decided to consolidate some precincts. Upon consultation with the attorneys assisting the County in this process the attached maps were proposed.

After review of the attached maps in Exhibit A of the Order to approve changes in the Election Precincts under Chapter 42 of the Texas Election Code and a discussion of the Election Code, Commissioner Russell made the motion to approve the Order adopting the 2021 revised Parmer County Election Precincts. Commissioner Frye seconded the motion and the motion passed. See attached Order.

2. Consider Approval of Joint Primary for the 2022 Primary Election.

Both the Republican and Democratic Parties have asked the Parmer County Clerk to contract with them for a Joint Primary. This is done every other year when a primary has been held in Parmer County for the past several years.

Upon motion by Wilkins to approve a Joint Primary, seconded by Russell, the motion passed.
