## Call to Order:

Sharon May, Treasurer, presented each member of the Court with a copy of the proposed 2023 Budget.

A line by line review of the revenue accounts was conducted.

All agreed that the ARPA monies should not be included in the budget, but rather accounted for separately.

A line by line review of the shared expense accounts was conducted. It was agreed that the phone expenses in each department in the Courthouse should be moved to a shared account as it is difficult to obtain a clean breakout from the bill.

Due to the fact that JP #1, JP #2, the Sheriff's office and the County Attorney's office are easily broken out on billing, it was agreed that those expenses will remain under those departments.

A brief discussion was held in regard to the distribution to each Precinct of \$50,000 each year. This was discussed and will be revisited at a later time.

Judge Ellis stated that the Appraisal District final numbers are due to the County on July  $25^{th}$ . The Judge suggested that Commissioners reconvene for a continued budget workshop on Monday, July  $25^{th}$  at 2 PM after the Commissioner's regular meeting that morning.
