Call to Order

1. Prayer

9. Consider and Discuss Continuing Education Hours for JP #3

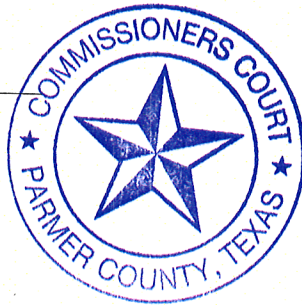
