### Call to Order

#### 1. Prayer

10. Consider and Discuss Vacating Portion of CR 15 – Cargill overpass


Judge Carrasco made motion to keep open portion of CR 15, for emergency use only, Commissioner Frye made seconded. Motion was passed by majority of votes.

11. Consider Any and All Matters Concerning the Parmer County Law Enforcement Center Including but not Limited to:


(A) Jail Roaster
