Call to Order

1. Prayer

Commissioner White led the Court in prayer to begin the meeting.

2. Pledge of Allegiance to the American Flag and the Texas Flag

3. Open Forum for Public Comments

No one present had comments.

4. Approve Minutes from Previous Meeting

Upon a motion to approve the minutes from the Regular Meeting on May 12, 2026, by Commissioner White, seconded by Commissioner Frye, the motion passed by a majority vote.

5. Consider Approval and Payment of Accounts Payable-Sharon May

Sharon May reported the Accounts Payable List for invoices for May 18th and 26th Motion by Commissioner Russell, seconded by Commissioner White to approve Payment of the Accounts Payable as presented. Motion carried by majority vote. See attached.

6. Consider Treasurer's Payroll Report-Sharon May

7. Consider and Discuss Electric Line under CR2/CR N

Richard Anderson has filed an application for placement of an electrical line under CR 2 ½ mile north of CR N.

Upon a motion from Commissioner Russell, seconded by Commissioner White, the motion passed with a majority vote.

8. Consider and Discuss Water Line under CR2/CR M

Richard Anderson has filed an application for placement of a water line under CR2/CR M.

Upon a motion from Commissioner Frye, seconded by Commissioner Russell, the motion passed with a majority vote.

9. Consider and Discuss Purchase of Motor Road Grader Caterpillar 140-15BAW8 for Pct. 3

Commissioner White presented a quote for a new grader to replace an old one from 2019. Cost of the new grader is \$395,000. The old grader will be traded in for a reduction of the purchase price by \$194,000. The new grader will cost \$201,000. See attached.

On a motion by Commissioner Frye to purchase the grader, seconded by Commissioner Russell, the motion passed by majority vote.

10. Consider and Discuss Matters Concerning the Parmer County Law Enforcement Center

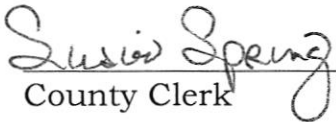
- A. Annual Maintenance Agreement between Parmer County Sherriff's Office and Midwest Auto-Chlor Dishwashing Service

Amy Dudley presented the maintenance agreement for the Sheriff's Department dishwashers. She noted an increase in cost from \$196.00 per month to \$262.00 per month.

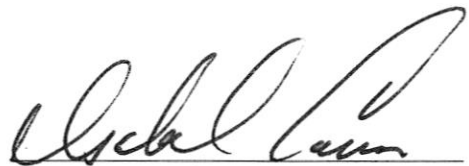
Commissioner White made a motion to accept the agreement and Commissioner Russell seconded. The motion passed by majority vote.
